 - International chili cook off rules **WILL NOT** apply
 - **NO** Alcoholic Beverages will be brought onto premises
 - Entrants give their permission to the Pioneer Day Committee to use their photo/photo's in Pioneer Day publications, social media etc.
 - Pioneer Day Committee will provide tasting kits
 - Teams will **NOT** dismantle their booth until 2pm

Pioneer Day Chili Cook-Off Rules/Regulations

1. Teams must submit an Entry Form with a check for \$25 per space, \$50 for electricity(2 spaces available) or \$35 for entries received after August 25th.
2. The cook-off site will open at 5 a.m. for registration and set up. Each Team is required to present food items and preparation area to cook-off officials prior to beginning. Once signed off...Let the games begin! Teams will start serving chili to the public at 11am.
3. Teams will be assigned a 10' x 10' preparation area.
4. All teams must consist of at least two people.
5. Each team is responsible for all cooking utensils, tables, chairs, cooking ingredients, set up and clean up. A tent or overhead covering of some sort is required.
6. Each team must supply all cooking equipment: propane camp stove, grills, generators, etc. (No electrical outlets are available, unless reserved. 2 spaces only)
7. **NO** chili can be pre-cooked or prepared prior to competition. **ALL** food preparation including meat, cutting of vegetables, etc. must be done on-site in a sanitary manner.
8. **ALL** ingredients **MUST** come from approved food sources, so it's absolutely safe for public consumption.
10. Teams are highly encouraged to decorate their area and themselves in the spirit of the event.
11. Each Team will be assigned a Team number and bucket with correlating number for the public to place tickets into. The public will each be given a ticket to give to their favorite chili and/or team. The team with the most tickets wins. It's up to you to entice them to try your chili and cast their vote for you. The more chili you have, the more votes you can get – but a minimum of 5 gallons is required.
12. The Chili Cook-Off officials will announce winning teams at 1:30pm.
13. All tasting kits will be provided by the Pioneer Day committee.
